GENERAL INFORMATION

When you apply:

Your application will be entered according to the time you apply. After considering the needs of each student as shown in the application, you will be informed of the dates and the timing of the classes in which you have been chosen.

WHEN LESSONS START:

Once your child is on the register, that is, after paying the admission and monthly fees, you will be asked to attend classes according to your schedule. You may pay online or on the registration day.

MISSED LESSONS

If the teacher is absent or the school is closed, lessons will be made up. If the pupil is absent, teachers will try to make it up when and if convenient.

INSTRUMENTS

Pupils must have an instrument which they can use to practice at home.

MOVING ON:

Once your child is learning, it is important that you take an active interest, communicating with the teacher via the Pupil Progress Book, encouraging them to practice daily and, as they progress further, enabling them to join periodic performances for parents and others to play with other young musicians, singers, dancers, drama students (whichever the case may be) of a similar standard.

RULES of the ACADEMY:

- a) The academy expects students to follow the rules set down. The foremost is to maintain discipline and good behaviour while attending classes and also while in the premises. The Academy reserves the right to expel a student for gross misbehaviour.
- b) Punctual attendance will also be required in order to avoid disruption while the class is going on. Regular attendance is necessary for the child's own benefit.
- c) . Cars dropping and picking up students should not back the cars while entering the road in front of the building. They should keep on going straight and take a turn to go to the next lane.
- d) Fees must be paid by the 5th day of every month failing which a fine will be attached to the next month of paying the fees. Two continuous months of such failures might lead to striking out the student's name from the register.
- e) Food items will not be allowed inside the premises of the Academy.
